

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
WOF = Width of fabric ${ }^{*}$ Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated FOR THE FOLLOWING FABRICS:
From $1 / 4$ yd, cut (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut: (2) $2-1 / 2 "$ x 40-1/2" strips

1/8 yd
(1) $4-1 / 2$ " x WOF strips, subcut
(1) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips

M HONEYCOMB SILHOUETTE 8644-12 Black
1 yd
(7) 4-1/2" x WOF strips*, subcut
(12) $4-1 / 2 " \times 32-1 / 2$ " strips
(12) $4-1 / 2$ " x $64-1 / 2$ " strips

N HONEYCOMB SILHOUETTE 8644-33 Yellow
3/4 yd
(12) Template A
(7) 2-1/4"x WOF strips*; Binding

QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY Refer to Quilt Diagram on back.
1 Sew 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips together, according to diagram to complete Section 1. Make 2.
2 Sew (1) Section 1 on each side of (1) F 4-1/2" x 40-1/2" strip. Refer to quilt diagram for proper rotation of the lower Section 1.

## APPLIQUE ASSEMBLY

3 Using your favorite method of applique prepare (12) Fabric $\mathbf{N}$ Template A pieces.
4 Applique (1) $\mathbf{N}$ Template A shape onto the diagonal of (1) M 4-1/2" square. Make 12.

## BORDER ASSEMBLY

Measure width and length of the quilt top to ensure border sizes, below are our cutting sizes. Refer to Quilt Diagram for proper rotation of MN squares.
5 Sew (1) MN square to each side of (1) 4-1/2" x (64-1/2") strip. Sew strip to each side of quilt top.
6 Sew (2) MN squares to each end of (1) M 4-1/2"x (32-1/2") strip. Sew strip to top and bottom of quilt top. Refer to Quilt Diagram for proper rotation of MN squares.


FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
